GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ALL PERMITS

Capture of game:

- X Seven day prior notice to Ministry of Environment and Tourism.
- X Where approval has been granted for capture by helicopter all adjoining neighbours must be informed at least one week beforehand.
- X Within thirty days after the expiry of the permit the holder must inform the Director in writing of the number of animals which were caught and which died.

Protected plants:

- X Only healthy plants may be imported and exported.
- X Where plants are exported the necessary import permits have to be obtained from the bodies concerned.

Hunting of protected game:

- X The game may not be hunted during the period from half an hour after sunset to half an hour before sunrise.
- X Only the permit holder may shoot game.
- X Within thirty days after the expiry of the permit the Director must be informed in writing of the number of animals shot, as well as the dates on which they were shot.

Import and export of trophies:

- X At all times subject to the veterinary requirements and approval.
- X Original import and export documents within fourteen days after import to this office.

Sale of game carcasses:

- X A register of the names, addresses and receipt numbers of buyers stating the quantity of meat sold per receipt must be kept up to date and sent to the Director on the expiry of the permit.
- X Every buyer must receive a receipt indicating how much meat were sold, and the number of the trophy permit must be indicated where the meat of the trophy animals were sold.
- X In urban areas municipal health regulations must be observed.
